### **TICKETED ENTRY TIMES**

All visitors will be required to select a specific entrance time to manage crowding, capacity and queuing.

- Online ticket purchases are strongly encouraged for all visits. We will not have capacity to sell on-site tickets.
- Online tickets will be available on the Centre's website with specific entry times set at appropriate intervals.
- For the moment, since we are not fully opening, we will continue hold and pause membership renewals until we fully re-open.

### **PLANNING YOUR VISIT**

To ensure the wellbeing of both Centre's staff and visitors, new safety protocols have been established:

- All visitors must self-assess before visiting the Centre. Please stay home if you are not feeling well.
- Visitors are strongly encouraged to wear self-provided masks.
- Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled time to avoid crowding.
- Coats and personal items will remain with the visitor.
- The outdoor program will limit the capacity and we will use markers and signage to prevent congestion.
- All visitors and staff must maintain a two-metre distance from each other. Household groups may remain together. Children must stay with an adult at all times.
- Markers will indicate appropriate spacing. All frontline staff will wear appropriate personal protective equipment.
- Hand sanitation stations will be placed at various locations and stringent cleaning practices will be in place throughout the program.
- Visitors may use the washrooms in the observatory space. All washrooms will be checked and cleaned throughout the day at appropriate intervals.
- High-touch points, such as service counters, will be cleaned after each program rotation.
